

# Wales Route 1: **Apprenticeship (All Ages 16+)**



## **BEFORE YOU START**

- 1) You must be employed before you can enrol onto an apprenticeship.
- 2) The apprenticeship training programme typically takes around 4 years to complete.
- 3) You do not pay for your training and will earn while you learn.



## **APPRENTICESHIP**

During your apprenticeship you'll be building practical skills and knowledge both on the job and with a training provider.

Across the four years you'll gain the Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Installing Electrotechnical Systems & Equipment (Buildings, Structures & the Environment), from City & Guilds or EAL. You'll be assessed on a wide range of performance criteria.



## **ASSESSMENT OF COMPETENCE**

To complete your apprenticeship you'll take the AM2 assessment which tests everything you've learnt during your training.



## **QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN**

Once you've passed your AM2 assessment your apprenticeship is complete and you'll be a qualified electrician.
