

Northern Ireland Route 1: **Apprenticeship Framework (16 - 24 years)**



BEFORE YOU START

- 1) You must be employed before you can enrol onto an apprenticeship.
- 2) The apprenticeship training programme typically takes around 4 years to complete.
- 3) You do not pay for your training and will earn while you learn.



APPRENTICESHIP FRAMEWORK

During your apprenticeship you'll be building practical skills and knowledge both on the job and with a training provider.

Across the four years you'll gain the competence-based Electrotechnical Apprenticeship Level 3 Qualification and the knowledge-based Level 3 Award in the Fundamental Principles and Requirements of Environmental Technology Systems. You'll also be assessed on a wide range of performance criteria.



END POINT ASSESSMENT

To complete your apprenticeship you'll take the AM2S assessment which tests everything you've learnt during your training.



QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN

Once you have completed the Electrotechnical Apprenticeship Level 3 Qualification and successfully passed the AM2S, you'll be a qualified electrician.

If the apprentice has to retake the End Point Assessment or other exams, these may have to be paid for by the candidate.

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
